On the summer solstice, Saturday June 21, will open an exhibition of selected works from the collection of the Institute. The exhibition presents supplies last ten years, while the works are carried out in the period from 1952 to 2014. Traces The title is creative and focuses on the museum as a place where the result of creative artists are preserved and shared with him. Different Trends involved in the show is a kind of journey through contemporary art, from the

formalism of modernist works Hard Ágústsson and Eric Smith since 1952 for new dramatic video of their works Ilmar Stefánsdóttir and Sigurdur Gudjonsson.

The works are by many of the country's best-known artists but also several foreign artists who have been associated with either museum exhibitions or stay in the guest studio collection. Nearly thirty artists exhibited here but among them are David Orn Halldorsson, Georg Guðni Gudrun Kristjánsdóttir, Hildur Bjarnadóttir, Clean Friðfinnsson, Olafur Eliasson and Elias Hjörleifsson, Sirr Sigrun Sigurdardottir and Stefan Jonsson. Furthermore showcased works by sequence (Sigrun Guðjónsdóttir) but she recently gave the museum more than a dozen works for a gift.

The exhibition provides a glimpse of the collection now of over 1400 works of art and has grown slowly in recent years. The museum traces its roots to all works of art of Sverris Magnusson and Ingibjargar Sigurjónsdóttir but they laid the foundation for Hafnarborg by moving Hafnarfjarðarkaupstaður his house and art collection as a gift. In Sverrissalur has been set up another show with paintings from the early 20th century, most of which are part of the founding gift to the couple.

Thursday 26 June at. 20 handles Ólöf K. Sigurðardóttir former Director guided the exhibition Traces of creation but Hafnarborg open until. 21 every Thursday. The exhibition runs until August 24.
